The Master of Public Administration was passed contingently with changes to the last sentence from the verbiage being encouraged to instead of invited to.

In Nursing the Program change to terminate the Bridge Program was unanimously approved by the committee.

The courses NGR 6296L, NGR 6297L, NGR 6770, NGR 6771, and NGR 6892, were all unanimously approved by the committee.

EDA 7928 was unanimously approved by the committee contingently with the addition of the Disability and Accommodations, and Code of Integrity included in the syllabi.

The program change: Professional Master of Science in Medical Physics was unanimously approved by the committee.

The program change: Graduate Remote Sensing Certificate was unanimously approved by the committee with changes to the wording the paragraph, and below the chart that the

students cannot use undergraduate GIS Certificate courses towards the Graduate Remote Sensing Certificate.

ITT 5805, SPC 6239, LIT 6408 were unanimously approved by the committee.

LIN 6674 was approved contingently by the committee with the addition of the Integrity and ADA code added to the syllabi.

The program change: Master of Accounting, Master of Taxation, Exec Master of Accounting, and Exec Mater of Taxation were unanimously approved by the committee.

ACG 5933, ACG 6936, ACG 7936 were taken as a group and were approved unanimously by the committee.

ACG 6498, MAN 6899 and GEB 7068 were unanimously approved by the committee.

ACG was unanimously approved contingent upon the addition of the old description so that we are able to see the difference in the verbiage.

MDI 8010, MDE 8011, MDE 8012 and BBC 8180 were unanimously approved by the committee contingent upon the ADA code be added to the syllabi, and the overview of the 4<sup>th</sup> year of the MD program be more explicit as to the rotations.
