Discussion of the Revision of Thesis and Dissertation Guidelines

Dr. Floyd announced the roll out of the revision. A discussion on having a workshop on how to write a proposal took place. Colleges/Departments should have guidelines or examples of proposals.

Discussion of Graduate Faculty

Lists of Graduate Faculty are updated three times a year. These lists are sent to all departments to be audited and certified and then sent back to the Graduate College. On

the fifth year, lists are sent about renewals. Individual colleges have their own graduate document to renew. Form 1 not necessary for renewal, only for new appointments. Engineering will review and approve grad faculty in two weeks. Science, Medicine, A&L responded. Renewals can begin now through September.

The question about background checks for Associate Graduate Faculty and Courtesy Appointments is not answered yet.

VI. Interim Graduate Dean's Report

Dr. Floyd discussed recruitment grant funds, funds to colleges between now and next Tuesday to spend additional money for student recruitment. These funds are non-recurring.

The Graduate College requests brochures to market programs. The Graduate College will hire a Communications person to assist with marketing.

Dr. Floyd congratulated Dr. Zilouchian on the grant he received.

Dr. Floyd spoke of partnerships with state colleges. Research on inventory of programs and the institutions providing them should be done. Work with faculty to articulate these programs should be done. The need of resources to help focus on master degrees was mentioned

This was the last meeting of the UGC until fall 2014. A new Chair will have to be chosen.
