FAU MINIMUMS: 120 cr. Total / 45 cr. upper div. / 30 cr. at FAU / Majors must complete a minimum of 42 credit hours of History courses with a “C” or better in each course.

HISTORY MINOR

MINIMUM 18 CR. / 15 cr. upper div., 15 at FAU / “C” minimum in all 18 credits, courses must cover at least two geographical areas (U.S., Europe, Latin American, World [AFH/ASH])
