- 3. LEED certified project managers
- 4. Evaluate recycling program
- 5. Educate the FAU community about recycling



Food Services

Current Sustainable Practices

- 1. Use of recycled products where possible
- 2. Purchase of only cage-free eggs
- 3. Balanced Choices Program supports local farmers, environmentally safe harvesting of fish
- 4. Prohibit the serving of chicken and pork from vendors where growth hormones are used
