In compliance with Section 1004.085, Florida Statutes, the Board of Governors promulgated Regulation 8.003 on March 26, 2009, and in turn on July 22, 2009, FAU's Board of Trustees promulgated Regulation 3.004 implementing this law designed to minimize the cost of textbooks to students while maintaining quality instruction and academic freedom.

During the June 10, 2009 BOT Audit and Finance Committee meeting, management agreed to report on compliance results.
