Its objective is to empower defense and commercial customers to operate at a higher level of efficiency and effectiveness. To this end, BMP has three core competencies represented by tools and resources that enable organizations to identify and apply best practices and become part of a vast, mutually supportive information exchange network:

Best Practices Surveys - conducted to identify, validate, and document best practices, and encourage government, industry, and academia to share information and implement the practices

Systems Engineering - facilitated by the Program Manager's WorkStation (PMWS), a suite of electronic tools that provide risk management, engineering support, and failure analysis through integrated problem solving

Web Technologies - offered through the Collaborative Work Environment (CWE) to provide users with an integrated digital environment to access and process a common set of documents in a geographically dispersed environment

**Abstract:** A best practice is an in-depth study of an organizational practice used in one or more organizations that enables an organization to measure and to understand outcomes of its practices. Based on the results of cases, surveys, and/or interviews involving a number of individuals or organizations, a best practice report often makes use of benchmarking in the systematic examination of a practice in a situation or organization. A best practice report is a special type of research presumed to contain valid, tested information about human behavior and processes. In conceiving, structuring, and writing a best practice, the writer should consider certain basic and conventional goals. Description follows.

**Abstract:** When used in moderation and carefully considered, best practices can be immensely valuable. The key is to have a framework by which to evaluate best practices so that you can determine which are really "best."

There are eight key considerations or questions to use when you are evaluating a best practice:

1. Who is the messenger or advocate, and what is in it for them?
2. Is it a well-constructed, multidimensional best practice or one-dimensional silver bullet?
3. What is the detailed ROI of the effort, and is it reasonable?
4. Is the opportunity compelling even when I discount the benefits significantly?
5. Is the best practice based on a practitioner's or a consultant's view of the world?
6. In other organizations who've adopted the best practice, who is talking about it?
7. How long have other organizations been doing it, and what have the results been? Are the results believable?
8. Can you keep the employees who may lead this effort working on it for the life of the initiative?
