Guest Policy

The College Panhellenic Association welcomes all students and organizations to our council meetings, held each Wednesday at 4:30 in House Chambers on the Boca Raton campus. To keep our meetings concise and business oriented, we abide by the following policy to allow guest speakers a place in our scheduled meetings.

- Guests must request to attend and be approved by no later than 5:00 pm on the Friday
 preceding the requested Wednesday meeting. If requests are made later than this time,
 or if the guest list is full, your time will be scheduled for the next scheduled council
 meeting.
- The allowed list of guest speakers will be limited to three per meeting

- Each guest speaker will have a maximum of five minutes for a presentation
- Please note that members present at the CPA council meetings are members of the
 Greek community, and the six CPA chapters' delegates. These delegates' duty is to bring
 back all information to their individual chapters. Therefore, the general purpose for
 guest speakers is to provide just enough information to delegates to inform them of
 services provided, event information, etc. Guest speakers must keep in mind that full
 presentations may be made to individual chapters upon request.
