CHANGE IN GRE SCORES REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION TO THE ED.S. IN CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION.

PROPOSED: CHANGE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO A MINIMUM OF:

148 (Verbal), 143 (Quantitative) and 3.5 (Writing) for students with an undergraduate GPA above 3.5 and graduate GPA above 3.4; 153 (Verbal), 145 (Quantitative) and 3.5 (Writing) for students with an 'undergraduate GPA 3.0-3.49; graduate GPA 3.25-3.39.

Rationale:

This represents a lowering of the current minimum requirements for students with higher GPAs. The lower requirement will allow for students not selected for the doctoral program to be eligible for the Ed.S. [The doctoral program has no stipulated minimum GRE requirement. Current requirements for the Ed.S: 153 (Verbal), 145 (Quantitative) and 3.5 writing; U-GPA: 3.0; G-GPA- 3.25.]
