THE CHANGE REQUESTED IS TO ADD ESOL EDUCATION TO THE LISTED OPTIONS FOR AN AREA OF SPECIALIZATION IN THIS DEGREE. THIS IS A PROGRAM AREA HOUSED IN THE DEPARTMENT AND OFFERS COURSEWORK RELEVANT TO THE DEGREE. CURRENT AREA OF SPECIALIZATIONS ARE LIMITED TO COURSEWORK OUTSIDE THE DEPARTMENT.

There are two options in ESOL education available to students in this program:

Option 1: Students who choose option 1 are eligible for the ESOL endorsement required by the state for all Florida's Category 1 public school teachers (who teach language arts, reading, and ESE students). This option will include the following five courses:

- TSL 4251- Applied Linguistics and TESOL
- TSL 5345- Methods of TESOL and Bilingual Education
- TSL 5142- Curriculum Development in TESOL and Bilingual Education
- TSL 5440- Assessment Issues for ESOL and Bilingual Populations
- EDG 5705 – Multicultural Education

Option 2: Students who are not Category 1 public school teachers may choose option 2 to meet the ESOL requirement as an area of specialization. This option will include the following four courses:

- TSL 5345- Methods of TESOL and Bilingual Education
- TSL 5142- Curriculum Development in TESOL and Bilingual Education
- TSL 5440- Assessment Issues for ESOL and Bilingual Populations
- EDG 5705 – Multicultural Education
