Course: ECO 6906: Directed Independent Study

Requested Change: This is a request for the course grading to change from S/U to a Regular

Letter Grade.

Purpose of Course: ECO 6906 allows students to pursue an independent study of a course that is not offered in the regular curriculum due to program resource constraints, but is a subject that is of high interest to the student and her/his faculty advisor.

Level of Course: ECO 6906 counts as a graduate elective within the Master of Science program in General Economics, Financial Economics, or International Economics. Students are expected to devote approximately the same amount of time and effort as a traditional 6000-level economics course.

Procedures: A student wishing to pursue a directed independent study must seek a qualified graduate faculty to advise and grade the student's work in the course. Once a topic is agreed upon and approved by the student, professor, and graduate director, the student is given permission to register and an official course name is attached to an ECO 6906 section.
