Graduate Programs—PROGRAM CHANGE REQUEST DEPARTMENT: SCHOOL OF SOCIAL WORK COLLEGE: CDSI PROGRAM NAME: MASTER OF SOCIAL WORK (MSW) EFFECTIVE DATE (PROVIDE TERM/YEAR) FALL 2013 PLEASE EXPLAIN THE REQUESTED CHANGE(S) AND OFFER RATIONALE BELOW AND/OR ATTACHED: The School of Social Work is updating its Master of Social Work (MSW) curriculum to meet the Council on Social Work Education (CSWE) accrediting requirements to prepare students for advanced entry into the social work profession. The curriculum provides MSW students the opportunity to meet educational qualifications for licensure in the State of Florida as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW). The degree requirement for the MSW is 60 semester credits. The program consists of the foundation curriculum (30 semester credits) and concentration curriculum (30 semester credits). A 30-credit Master of Social Work degree Advanced Standing program is available to a limited number of applicants who have earned their BSW degree from a CSWE-accredited program. The Advanced Standing students are required to complete the concentration curriculum (30 semester credits). The MSW program is designed for full-time or planned part-time students. Full-time students take up to 15 credits each semester that includes classroom coursework and a field practicum (internship). The planned parttime program is designed for the student to take 6 to 9 credits each semester. Once approved, it is requested that the curriculum changes be included in the catalog. See attached. Current MSW Curriculum

The foundation curriculum provides students with a foundation of theoretical knowledge, practice skills and professional values necessary for delivering quality social work services. Currently the concentration curriculum provides an advanced level of knowledge and skill in the focus areas of children, adolescents and families; adults and families; or elders and families. The MSW student is required to select one focus area, which corresponds to the population with which they work in their concentration year field practicum. The following is the sequence of classes that full-time students currently take in their foundation and concentration years. Advanced standing students are required to take only the concentration year.

Proposed MSW Curriculum

The School of Social Work faculty, by a vote of 10 in favor and none opposed, propose modifications to the current curriculum. This proposed curriculum replaces classes focusing on executive functions such as administration, supervision and evaluation in order to provide students with a broader specialized knowledge and skill base in practice with children, adults <u>and</u> elders. As a result, the student is not limited to one focus area, but has the benefit of exposure to all three focus areas. Additionally, foundation students would be exposed to the Diagnostic and Statistical Manual of Mental Disorders in SOW 6125 Psychopathology in Clinical SW Practice to better meet the demands of their first field practicum.

The following is the proposed sequence of classes that full-time students would take in their foundation and concentration curriculum. Advanced standing students would be required to take only the concentration year, however, for these students only SOW 6125 Psychopathology in Clinical SW Practice would replace the fourth elective since this course is not offered in the BSW program.
