Re: Termination of Graduate Certificate in Piano Performance and Pedagogy

Date: February 12, 2013

The Department of Music wishes to terminate the Graduate Certificate in Piano Performance and Pedagogy. The certificate was evaluated by the National Association of Schools of Music, our accrediting body, which recommended that the department reconsider the program in light of low enrollment and completion rates.

The certificate was completed by only two students, and the student currently enrolled decided to transfer into the MA program instead of completing the certificate. At the time the certificate was created, there was no specialty track within the Master of Arts in Music that would lead to expertise in piano performance and study of piano pedagogy. However, now those courses are offered within the Performance Track in the Master of Arts degree, so students can earn the MA degree instead of a certificate.

The department concurs with NASM's assessment of the viability of the program, and requests termination.
