We are requesting the removal of the Comprehensive Exam requirment for students on the internship track for completing the MA.

The current work required for the internship option is extensive. To complete the Internship, students must: (1) write a 10 page proposal, describing and justifying the subject of the Internship and the placement, which must be approved by the Director; (2) Write a 20-25 page research paper on the background and history of the kind or organization (e.g., a domestic violence advocacy group); the results of their internship, the ways in which this work relates to the critical literature and theory of Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies; and (3) an assessment of their work from the agency, usually a letter or email to the Director that summarizes the intern's work performance and accomplishments and which may take the form of a letter of recommendation.
