Department of Educational Leadership and Research Methodology

Department of Curriculum, Culture and Educational Inquiry

This innovative certificate program is designed for teacher leaders, leaders of teachers and aspiring leaders who are seeking collaboration, expertise and skill as coordinators, coaches, team leaders, department chairs, professional development facilitators and more. Teacher leaders will explore tools and approaches to mentoring, assessment and data analysis to meet the needs of all students, while working with adults from diverse backgrounds in school and district settings. Teacher leaders will gain valuable practice regarding how to build and support culturally responsive classrooms and schools and develop plans for ongoing authentic peer coaching and in-classroom support in their schools. Courses are designed to address specific national standards for Teacher Leadership.

This program is offered entirely online. The five courses are offered in a rotation during the fall, spring and summer semesters and can be completed in one year or three semesters.

The program will include five courses: three from the Department of Educational Leadership and Research Methodology, and two from the Department of Curriculum, Culture and Educational Inquiry. The courses are as follows:
