The difference between FY 2013-2014 and FY 2014-2015 regarding the Physical Library Circulation is due to the instructions to not include renewals in this category which have been included in the past. The difference between FY 2013-2014 and FY 2014-2015 regarding the Digital/Electronic Databases is due to a vendor repackaging a product that combined multiple databases into overall subject packages. The difference between FY 2013-2014 and FY 2014-2015 regarding the Digital/Electronic Media is due to the instructions to count e-media titles in aggregated sets, graphic materials and cartographic materials in this category which has not been done in the past. The difference between FY 2013-2014 and FY 2014-2015 regarding the Digital/Electronic Library Circulation is due to instruction changes. FY 2013-2014 did not ask for transactions of digital/electronic databases which are now included.
