## NATIONAL RECOGNITION AS LEADER IN STUDENT SUCCESS

FAU was recognized by the Association of Public and Landgrant Universities as one of three finalists in the nation for the prestigious Degree Completion Award. FAU also received the 2021 Higher Education Excellence in Diversity Award from *INSIGHT Into Diversity* magazine, the largest diversity-focused higher education publication.

### **TOP 40**

FAU is ranked among the top 40 universities nationwide for social mobility by U.S. News & World Report. At FAU, Pell-eligible students, first-generation students, African American students and Hispanic students all outpace the university's overall retention and graduation rates.

#### Historic Gift for New Holocaust and Jewish Studies Building

Thanks to a historic \$20 million gift - the largest in FAU's history -FAU will become a key location for intercultural dialogue and education in South Florida. Kurt and Marilyn Wallach's transformational gift includes \$10 million to construct the Kurt and Marilyn Wallach Holocaust and Jewish Studies Building, a distinctive facility on FAU's Boca Raton campus.



### Hispanic-Serving Institution

FAU received federal designation as a Hispanic-Serving Institution by the United States Department of Education in 2017.

### New Rivalries Await in The American

On Oct. 21, 2021, FAU announced plans to join the American Athletic Conference, giving the university opportunity for exposure in four of the top 10, seven of the top 25, and 12 of the top 51 Nielsen media markets. The Owls will face four teams from Texas, two from North Carolina and one each from Louisiana,



Tennessee and Alabama, in addition to first-time conference opponents in Pennsylvania, Maryland, Oklahoma and Kansas.

#### Madden Center Molds 'Millionaire Mindset'

The College of Business received \$3 million from the Bartley J. Madden Foundation to create the Madden Center for Value Creation, which will engage students through education, research and service regarding value creation as a foundational guiding principle to achieve widespread prosperity.

The Leon Charney Diplomacy Program placed first overall at the National Model United Nations competition in Washington, D.C., in 2021, adding to national titles in 2020 and 2018.

### Novel Technology Earns 2nd U.S. Patent

A new technology for autonomous systems for self-driving cars based on machine-learning and artificial intelligence to mimic human driving behavior has earned a second competitive utility patent from the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

### A.D. Henderson University School Ranked Second in America for K-5

The A.D. Henderson University School is the No. 2 Best Public **Elementary School** and moved up two spots to the No. 9 Best Public Middle School in America in the 2021 rankings published by Niche, the largest website for researching public and private K-12 schools. FAU High School was ranked 2nd for Best Public High School in Florida.



### Career Opportunities

The Disney College Internship Program has chosen FAU as a designated university for on-campus recruitment.



### eSports Arena and Gaming Area

The Student Union eSports Arena is a premier gaming center on the Boca Raton campus. The high-tech environment features 40 top-of-the-line gaming PCs, as well as screens for console gaming, billiards and table tennis.

### Taking Life Science to New Heights

The new 58,000-squarefoot, \$35 million Neuroscience Research Building on the John D. MacArthur campus in Jupiter is a hub for the life sciences. The building will house the Stiles-Nicholson Brain Institute and allow for expansion of collaborative research in neuroscience and other STEM areas especially with partners Scripps Florida and the Max Planck Florida Institute for Neuroscience.

#### Schmidt Family Complex for Academic and Athletic Excellence

This 166,000 squarefoot-facility is a national model of academic excellence in athletics, designed to attract the best coaches and student-athletes to FAU. The complex features academic support and athletic training facilities, athletic staff offices and entertainment venues. It also is home to the Avron B. Fogelman Sports Museum, a permanent exhibit featuring more than 1,200 artifacts from the former Kansas City Royals owner and longtime Boca Raton resident's private collection.

### Largest in the U.S.

The Osher Lifelong Learning Institute, located on the Boca Raton, Jupiter and Fort Lauderdale campuses, is the largest program of its kind in the United States.

### **Military Friendly**

FAU earned the 2021-22 Military Friendly® School "Gold Designation" for the second time, based on the expansion of services and spaces offered by the university's Military and Veterans Student Success Center.

### Artificial Intelligence Sandbox

The Rubin and Cindv Gruber Sandbox within the S.E. Wimberly Library on the Boca Raton campus is home to the Charles E. Schmidt College of Science's Machine Perception and **Cognitive Robotics** Lab. The Sandbox is one of the nation's first multi-disciplinary, state-of-the-art artificial intelligence labs located in a university library.

### Carnegie Classification

FAU has received the Carnegie Community Engagement Classification, an elective designation that indicates institutional commitment to community engagement. The award highlights the exceptional work of FAU's world-class outreach programs and partnerships.




### BEZOS ACADEMY COMING TO BOCA RATON CAMPUS


