**REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER:** Administrative Organization (1.002).

**SUMMARY:** FAU Regulation 1.002 sets forth the University's administrative organization. The proposed amendments update the regulation to delete outdated governance references and to reflect current organizational titles and add clarity to the scope of delegated responsibilities. This regulation amendment shall be effective August 6, 2012.



## **Regulation 1.002** Administrative Organization



<sup>—(2)</sup> \_The academic programs of the University shall be administered by the Colleges. Creation of a new College shall require study and recommendation by the University senate Faculty Senate and approval by the President, and the Board of Regents Trustees, and, as appropriate, the Board of Governors. The President grants degrees on the recommendation of the faculties of the several Colleges. The Deans of the several Colleges shall administer the academic and budgetary

policies of the Colleges and are responsible to the Vice President for Academic Affairs University Provost.

- —(3) Academic units such as the Library and , Division of Learning Resources, Computer Center, Office of the Registrar, Institutes , Division of Sponsored Research, Division of Continuing Education, and similar University agencies shall be administered by the Vice President for Academic Affairs University Provost unless otherwise specified by the President.
- —(4) Organizational Chart. The graphic description of lines of authority on file in the President's office shall be the organization of the University until changed by the President as prescribed by these rules regulations.
