FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNVIERSITY NOTICE OF PROPOSED REGULATION REPEAL

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Declaratory Statements (1.006).

SUMMARY: Regulation 1.006 was last amended in 1987. The Regulation references the administrative rules of the Florida Administrative Commission as governing the University regulation process. Since the establishment of the Board of Governors and Boards of Trustees as constitutional entities, the Florida Administrative Code is no longer applicable to the University. Also, Regulation 1.006 references and Florida Statute 120.565, which no longer applies to the University. Accordingly, Regulation 1.006 is antiquated and no longer relevant or applicable to the University.
