REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Continuing Education (3.001).

SUMMARY: Regulation 3.001 was originally drafted in 1975, and last revised in 1987. It details procedures for continuing education courses which were implemented, conducted or coordinated through the Dean of Continuing Education. The Office of the Dean of Continuing Education was eliminated at Florida Atlantic University in 2003. Policies and procedures for continuing education programs are now incorporated into Regulation 3.002 (New Academic Degree Program and Other Academic Program Approval).
