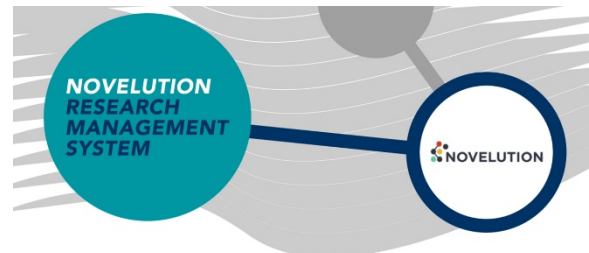

**NOVELUTION:** We continue to enhance the



features in the Novelution system. The latest new feature is one that many have requested. Salary information is now automatically populated, coming directly from Workday. You can still override the salary for those cases when you are aware of upcoming salary increases.

The Office of Research Development can now track the proposals that their office assists with and can pull a report to measure metrics. Additionally, the system can now accept multiple cost share tags from the same source.
