STREAM WITH XFINITY ON CAMPUS

We offer Cable TV Services through Xfinity on Campus as part of your FAU Housing experience. Xfinity on campus is a streaming service, so you will no longer need a coax cable or cable box. You can stream more than 100 live TV channels and thousands of Xfinity On Demand shows and movies directly to your laptop, desktop, and mobile devices while staying connected to the FAU campus network. You can record and watch two shows at once, you have 20 hours of recording storage, and you can download and watch even when you are offline. Includes channels such as HBO, CINEMAX, ESPN, and much more. The instructions to set up specific devices can be found on the this link:

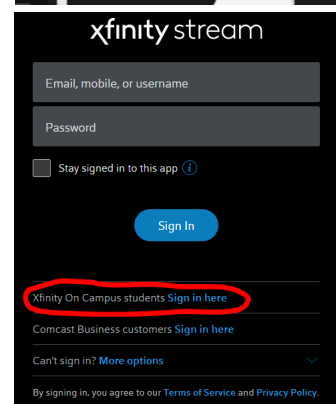
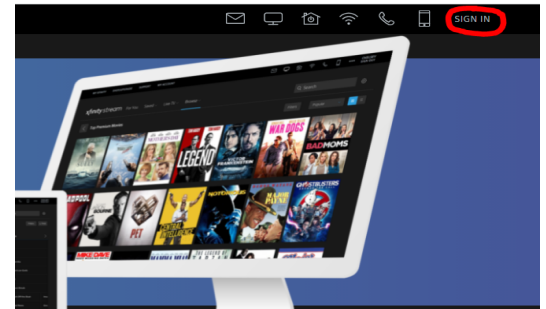
