

Jumpstart Your Master's Degree DURING YOUR SENIOR YEAR



COMBINED DEGREE PROGRAM:

Master of Science in Criminology and Criminal Justice (MSCCJ)

Did you know you can complete up to 12 credits toward your graduate degree *during your senior year* at Florida Atlantic? That's *more than a third* of the total hours you need to earn your master's degree! Talk about a jumpstart.

How it works: During senior year, high-achieving students can complete nine master's-level credits, or 12 with approval from the graduate coordinator. Those courses then count toward bachelor's electives AND toward a MSCCJ degree, and get you on the fast-track toward success.

What You Need to Apply:

- 3.5 GPA or higher in your 60 most recent undergrad credits
- · Letter of intent
- · Letter of recommendation from a professor
- · Academic writing sample
- "B" or better in Statistics
- · "B" or better in Research Methods

How to Apply:


- 1) Complete your online application: fau.edu/graduate/applyonline
- 2) Upload your letter of intent and writing sample.
- 3) Enter the name and email of the professor who will write letter of recommendation. Then ask your professor to check their email for the link to upload their recommendation to GradCAS.
- 4) Submit your application and \$50 fee.
