<b>FAU Repeat Course Policy</b>			
The FAU Repeat Course policy limits a student to two attempts at taking the same course (FAU or at any other institution). An attempt includes "W" or "U" or "Letter Grade" that does not meet the required grade for the major.			
Students attempting any course for a third time must obtain authorization from their declared college before registering for the course.
