## Admissions Policy

To be admitted to upper-division selective majors in the College of Business, students must meet the following criteria:

- Earn a minimum of 60 credit hours
- Attain a minimum cumulative transfer undergraduate GPA of 2.50
- Complete the pre-professional business courses, or equivalents, with “C” or better grades (ACG 2021, ACG 2071, ECO 2013, ECO 2023, ISM 2000, MAC 2233, and STA 2023)
- Fulfill Florida CLAS requirements (or exemption)
- Fulfill Florida Foreign Language Entry requirements

Students, who have not met the criteria, may be admitted to the lower-division pre-business major (PBUS). Most 3000–4000 level business courses are limited to students admitted to upper-division (a major program). A student must be admitted to upper-division in order to receive a bachelor’s degree from the college.

General economics is exempt from the above admissions policy. Students wishing to major in this program are eligible to do so upon acceptance by the University.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### What classes should I take at a Florida State College before coming to the College of Business?

If you have started to study at a Florida State College, we recommend you complete the associate’s degree and include our pre-professional courses as part of your degree.

The pre-professional courses are:

- Macroeconomics – ECO 2013
- Microeconomics – ECO 2023
- Principles of Accounting I (Financial) – ACG 2021\*\*
- Principles of Accounting II (Managerial) – ACG 2071
- Methods of Calculus – MAC 2233
- Introductory Statistics – STA 2023
- Information Systems Fundamentals – ISM 2000 (CGS 1570, CGS 1000, CGS 1100 or CGS 1060 are acceptable)

*\*\* some state colleges teach this as two courses, ACG 2001 and 2011*

If you need additional credits for your A.A. degree, courses in communications (speech, foreign language and interpersonal & small group communications) are recommended as electives. Lower-division courses in business law, business/technical writing, management, marketing or finance from community colleges do not equate to upper-division business classes at FAU.

### Can I complete my undergraduate business degree from FAU online?

### What are the Florida CPA exam requirements?

The Office of Undergraduate Studies is not directly involved with the process of obtaining a CPA certification. Students who desire to take the CPA

examination in Florida are required to have a bachelor’s degree, 30 credits beyond such a degree and specific accounting and business-related courses within those course requirements. For information about specific requirements, see the School of Accounting’s CPA Information web pages.
