

## International Undergraduate Admissions Options

**Academic Support:** Students with TOEFL scores of 550 or above are considered to be language proficient and do not need language support, but they may need additional academic support based on their entry GPA. These students are eligible for either direct admission or admission to undergraduate studies through the “Navitas at FAU Pathway.”

**Language Support:** Students with TOEFL score in the 500 to 549 (47 to 60 IBT) range meet the minimum language proficiency for admission to undergraduate studies at Florida Atlantic University, but language support will be required to ensure academic success. These students will be admitted through the “Navitas at FAU Pathway” or via the “Pathways to Academic Readiness.”

**Language Training:** Students with TOEFL scores below 500 (47 IBT) do not meet the minimum language proficiency for direct admission to undergraduate studies at Florida Atlantic University. The university provides a number of language training programs to prepare these students for admission.
