After studying philosophy and religious studies as an undergraduate at Tulane University in New Orleans, Billie Grace Lynn went on to earn an MFA in Sculpture at the San Francisco Art Institute. She is currently an Associate Professor of Sculpture at the University of Miami. Grace Lynn has had solo exhibitions of her work in California, Florida, New York, Pennsylvania, Washington, and in China, and has participated in numerous group exhibitions: the Museum of Art & Design, New York City; Museum of Contemporary Art, Georgia; SPACES Gallery, Cleveland; Yerba Buena Center for the Arts, San Francisco; Bernice Steinbaum Gallery, Miami; and MOCA/Goldman Warehouse, Miami. Grace Lynn has won several awards and fellowships, including a 2007 South Florida Cultural Consortium grant, and fellowships from Art Matters and the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture. This past summer she toured with her Mad Cow motorcycle across the country, participating in the Harley Museum exhibition of classic motorcycles and at the Sturgis Motorcycle Museum during their annual rally. She plans to return to the road next summer with her Mad Cow for more adventures.
