- If an insufficient amount of Italian majors or minors apply, selection will also be made based on proven commitment to further the study of Italian language and culture at FAU and in the community.
- Min. 2.80 GPA;
- Applicants must write a min.300-word statement tracing their profile, explaining the reason for applying and articulating how funds will be used; they shall also include a statement containing a firm commitment to participate in a scholarship recognition award ceremony hosted by II Circolo during the month of November;
- Deposit must be received by the office of International Programs at time of application for the program in Venice.
- By submitting this application, you authorize the Office of Student Financial Aid to release information pertaining to your financial aid eligibility to the FAU Foundation for the purposes of determining scholarship eligibility.
