APPLICATION FOR GRADUATE ASSISTANTSHIP WOMEN'S STUDIES CENTER

The Women's Studies Center (WSC) has a limited number of graduate assistantships available for the most qualified applicants. These assistantships provide a stipend (\$8,000 for 2006-2007) and 100 percent tuition waiver for nine graduate credits per semester (students are responsible for fees). In order to qualify, a student must be enrolled full-time (nine graduate credits per semester) and available to contribute to the WSC twenty hours weekly. In most cases, the assistantships are renewable for up to two years. In order to receive a graduate assistantship in Women's Studies, you must first be admitted into the M.A. program as a degree-seeking student.

During the first year, graduate assistants will work with faculty to learn about the mechanics of teaching, research, and programs in the WSC. The second year of the assistantship includes supervised responsibility for a lower-division class, either Introduction to Women's Studies or Introduction to Sexuality and Gender Studies. Faculty and assistants will meet often to review pedagogical and research concerns.

You should submit this graduate assistantship application with your Women's Studies Application. Once we have confirmation of your acceptance into the program, we will evaluate your assistantship application. Please note that applications received after July 1 for the fall semester and December 1 for the spring semester may not be considered for an assistantship.
