PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approval of Florida Atlantic University's 2011-12 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Florida Board of Governors requires that each university and college provide an annual update of its Capital Improvement Plan (CIP). The CIP is intended to present additional academic and academic support facilities needed for a five year period. This update is used by the Florida Board of Governors (BOG) to develop the annual Fixed Capital Legislative Budget Request. Additionally, BOG procedures require any proposed language for the 2011-12 Appropriations Bill, concerning the following legislative approval actions, be submitted with the initial CIP request on August 1, 2010:

- 1. projects funded from external institutional sources which require general revenue for operation **No projects identified for 2011-12**
- **2.** projects financed with long-term debt or other long-term obligations, including direct support organization projects **No projects identified for 2011-12**
- 3. previous legislative authorizations for which universities are requesting revisions None
