**SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE UNIVERSITY'S FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN FAU BOT AND THE TOWN OF JUPITER**

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**PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

Approval of the University's First Amendment to the Amended and Restated Campus Development Agreement (CDA) between the Florida Atlantic University and the Town of Jupiter.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

In accordance with section 1013.30, Florida Statutes, state universities are to address the impacts of campus development on their host cities. After a university adopts a campus master plan, it addresses those impacts through a CDA prepared in conjunction with the host city. The Town and FAU entered into an amended and restated CDA in 2009 (2009 CDA). The First Amendment to the 2009 CDA, extends the term until December 1, 2020 to allow FAU adequate time to finalize the update to the master plan and negotiate a new Campus Development Agreement.

The First Amendment to the CDA addresses the continuing impact of FAU's campus development as approved under the 2009 CDA.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED  
CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN

This **FIRST AMENDMENT** ("Amendment") is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_ ("Effective Date") by and between the **TOWN OF JUPTIER, FLORIDA** (hereinafter referred to as the "Town"), a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, and the **FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES**, (herein after referred to as "FAU" or "FAUBOT") a public body corporate of the State of Florida.

WHEREAS, the Town and FAU are parties to an Amended and Restated Campus Development Agreement dated December 1, 2009, pursuant to Section 1013.30(15), Florida Statutes (the "CDA");

WHEREAS, the Town and FAU now desire to amend the CDA to mutually extend the duration of the agreement beyond the initial date of December 1, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants contained herein and the performance thereof, the parties do hereby agree as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated as though fully set forth herein.
2. Article 5.0 of the CDA is hereby amended to extend the duration of the CDA for a period of one additional year, until December 1, 2020.
3. Except as specifically modified by this Amendment, all other provisions of the CDA shall remain in full force and effect and shall be binding upon the parties in accordance with their terms.
