BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The University's main accrediting body, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), requires governing boards to define and regularly evaluate their responsibilities and expectations as a board. This requirement was presented to this Board at its September 2020 retreat. At that time the Administration shared with the Board a self-evaluation survey that the Board of Governors (BOG) administered to its members in compliance with the SACSCOC requirement. Trustees were invited to provide feedback on how such a survey should be conducted for this Board.

With that feedback, the Administration has revised BOG's survey form to apply to this Board. The proposed survey form is attached. The Administration seeks final feedback on the content of the proposed survey and consent to administer it to the Trustees. The results will be tabulated, presented, and discussed at an upcoming Board meeting.

This Board should complete two self-evaluations – one by 2021, another by 2023 – before the University's next SACSCOC accreditation reaffirmation in 2024.

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN/DATE

Following the Board's acceptance of the content of the survey, the survey will be administered electronically to the Trustees by March and the results discussed with the Board at its April 20, 2021 meeting.
