SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF PROPOSED 2014-15 HOUSING RENTAL RATES.

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Review and approve the proposed Housing rental rates for the next fiscal year.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Department of Housing and Residential Life is proposing rate increases for the 2014-15 fiscal year. FAU Housing operates as an auxiliary operation and must maintain a positive cash flow and meet minimum debt service coverage ratio as required under bond covenants. The proposed increases are necessary to meet these requirements.

Fall/Spring: Single and Double Rooms: Average increase of 1.6% Summer: Single and Double Rooms: Average increase of 1.6%

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN/DATE

Fall 2014.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Rate proposal will increase contract revenue by approximately \$105,000.

Highlights and Goals for FAU Housing

- Retention of students to improve graduation rates
- Provide stability in rates for current residents in order to increase the number of returning students to FAU Housing
- Continue to meet our fixed costs (debt service, overhead, and minor repairs & renovations)
- Reinstate the Living Learning Communities
- Average occupancy rate over the last 5 years has been 93%

Proposed Changes for 2014-2015

- Consulted with each of the Residence Hall Association Councils
- Current students who sign up <u>by</u> April 30 will retain the 2013-14 rate
- For new students and current students who sign up <u>after April 30</u>, there will be an average rate increase of 1.6% for 2014-15
