Research Summary of years 1-5 of FAU Strategic Plan





Research Summary, Years 1-5 of FAU Strategic Plan

- · All 4 Pillars formed,
 - o All 4 executive directors recruited, 36 faculty recruited/hired.
 - Supporting Research Infrastructure developed (technology, seminars, grad students/post docs, pilot project funding, labs and facilities)
 - \$27.3M invested over 5 years, resulting in \$57.8M of new awards (ROI = 2.1)
- · Federal lobbying program established
 - o \$13M for food security, \$11M for national defense, \$5M for clean energy
- Overall FAU increased research activity (2020 vs 2015):
 - o Grant applications up 1.4x
 - Awards up 1.9x
 - o Expenditures up 2.2x
 - o F&A up 2x
 - Scholarly Publications up 1.3x



Q1-Q3 F&A recovery was \$5.3M



<u>Federal Lobbying – Major Areas of Opportunity</u>

- Cyclical Meetings with Congressional staff held every 3 months
 - o Oct/Nov Submit language for requests
 - Feb/Mar Defend language in Committee/markup
 - o April/May determine if requests made it into proposed legislation
 - o Oct projects approved, await agency RFP's, compete for funding
- Successful engagements
 - o National Defense, \$11M
 - o Food Security, \$13M
 - o Clean Energy, \$5M
- Current requests
 - o Plus up for clean energy
 - o HABs and human health
 - Emergency Management (Mesonet)
 - o Al and Data Science




Project #3 - Jupiter Neuroscience

Research Partnership – Memorial Health System



- Memorial Health System Research Affiliation Agreement
 - FAU created Clinical Research Faculty (CRF) Appointments for MHS clinicians
 - MHS CRF can submit grants through FAU Office of Sponsored Programs
 - FAU and MHS working on a structure to work collaboratively on clinical trials
- Joint Research
 - Cancer Center of Excellence Award
 - Data Science using MHS Epic EMR system
 - · Collaborative clinical trials
 - Collaborative clinical Research
- · Joint management and oversight of the collaboration
 - FAU will provide Technology Transfer services to MHS
