## SUBJECT: APPROVE NAMING OF UNIVERSITY ELEMENTS

## **PROPOSED BOARD ACTION**

Approve naming of the resource commons area in front of the Media Center within the proposed AD Henderson University School/FAU High School Complex (the "ADHUS/FAU High School Complex"). The proposed name of the resource commons area will be the "Jon and Melissa Cipyak Commons."

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

#### **Donation**:

Jon L. Cipyak IV and Melissa Cipyak are donating Twenty-Five Thousand Thirty-One Dollars (\$25,031) for a recognition opportunity to name the resource commons area in front of the Media Center of the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex.

#### Gift Purpose:

The gift will be used to assist with the planning, financing, constructing and equipping of the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex. The new facility is critical in facilitating student led research and engineering as AD Henderson University School/FAU High School provides opportunities for experiences beyond the classroom. This new facility will equip our faculty and students to impact the future for years to come.

#### Donor's Background:

Jon L. Cipyak IV '01 serves as Vice President for Builders Plus, a tilt-up contractor that has built schools, government buildings, corporate, and commercial buildings. He earned his B.A. in Elementary Education from Florida Atlantic University in 2001 and his M.Ed. in Educational Leadership from Florida Atlantic University in 2001 and his M.Ed. in Educational Leadership from Florida Atlantic University in 2002.

Melissa N. Cipyak is an ESE Teacher Assistant for Alexander D. Henderson University School. She has served as a member of the FAUS School Advisory Board and the A.D. Henderson University School PTO, Inc. Since 2001, she has been a licensed speech-language pathologist in the state

of Florida. She is an alumna of the University of Central Florida where she was a member of Kappa Delta Sorority.

The Cipyaks' two children attend AD Henderson University School. This gift is their second to the planned ADHUS/FAU High School Complex. The dollar amount of \$25,031 represents a \$25,000 donation, and \$31 to represent the year of their son's graduation.

The couple resides in Boynton Beach, Florida.
