SUBJECT: CERTIFICATION OF TENURE PROCESS FOR 2019-20

PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

No action is necessary. This item is only informational.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

According to FAU Regulation 5.006 – Tenure Procedures, the President shall make the final decision on the granting of tenure for faculty members.

- In 2020, the University awarded tenure to 38 faculty members, who were also promoted to the rank of associate professor.
- Additionally, the University promoted 18 associate professor to the rank of full professor.

Now that the tenure review process is complete, the President certifies to the FAU Board of Trustees that all the required tenure procedures have been followed.

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN/DATE

The President's decision is final upon certification to the Board of Trustees and will constitute final action of the University.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Tenure status guarantees annual reappointment for the academic year until voluntary resignation, retirement, removal for just cause or layoff, in accordance with state law, Board of Governors regulations and applicable collective bargaining agreements.
