Recommend that the BoT approves naming of the Student Success Center within the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex (the "ADHUS/FAU High School Complex"). The proposed name of the Student Success Center will be the "Henrietta Penn Student Support Suite".

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Donation:

Mickey Zitzmann, Katie Zitzmann, Joshua Smith, Beth Graham Smith and Anneliese Smith have given a combined amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) for a recognition opportunity to name the Student Success Center of the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex.

Gift Purpose:

The gift will be used to assist with the planning, financing, constructing, equipping and operation of the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex, under the direction and within the discretion of the Assistant Dean of PK-12 Educational Programs.

Donor's Background:

Henrietta A. Penn

Henrietta A. "Hank" Penn, née Skibba (1924-2015) served as a teacher for Milwaukee Public Schools for twenty years. She married her husband, Donald W.
