#### PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Provide approval of the proposed Housing rental rates for the next fiscal year.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Department of Housing and Residential Life is proposing rate increases for the 2013-14 fiscal year. Housing operates as an auxiliary operation at FAU and must maintain a positive cash flow and meet minimum debt service coverage ratio as required under bond covenants. The proposed increases are necessary to meet these requirements.

Fall/Spring: Double Rooms: 0% - 3% Single Rooms: 3% - 5% Summer: Double Rooms: 0% - 7% Single Rooms: 0% - 6%

This information was reviewed and approved by the BOT Audit and Finance Committee on April 16, 2013.

Fall 2013.

#### **FISCAL IMPLICATIONS**

The increases in rental rates will produce an additional income of \$498,000.
