BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Board of Governors is phasing out the *Limited Access* program in favor of a tweaked version now called *Specialized Admissions*. Undergraduate programs that have admission requirements above and beyond the general admission requirements for undergraduates at the institution must be approved for such. All programs that were previously approved for *Limited Access* must now reapply for *Specialized Admission* status. New programs without previous *Limited Access* permission may also use this opportunity to apply for the new program.

Programs asking for *Specialized Admission* status must fall into one or more of the following categories:

<u>Limited Resources</u>—Student demand for the program exceeds the program's available resources.

<u>Minimal Skills/Talents</u>—The program requires that students demonstrate through an audition or portfolio submission that they possess the minimum skills or talents to benefit from instruction in the program.

<u>Accrediting Body Requirements</u>—An accrediting body imposes requirements for the undergraduate program that may impose restraints on resources or require minimal skills.

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN/DATE

Effective Spring 2023, pending approval by the Florida Atlantic University Board of Trustees.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will not be an impact on enrollment, enrollment planning, or allocation of resources.
