## SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE 2023-24 E&G CARRYFORWARD SPENDING PLAN.

## PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

- 1. Approval of the 2023-24 University E&G Carryforward Spending Plan of \$120,293,902.
- 2. Authorize the President, in consultation with the Chairman of the Board of Trustees, to make adjustments as needed to the Carryforward Spending Plan during the fiscal year that are consistent with applicable laws, regulations, and University policy and within the available resources indicated in motion 1.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

University boards of trustees shall adopt an E&G Carryforward Spending Plan as prescribed by the Board of Governors regulation 9.007, State University Operating Budgets and Requests. The ratified plan for the fiscal year 2023-24 will also be presented to the Board of Governors for approval.

## IMPLEMENTATION PLAN/DATE

The Florida Atlantic University Board of Trustees approved the Carryforward Spending Plan, submitted annually by September 30<sup>th</sup> to the Board of Governors for ratification.

## FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

E&G carryforward funds provide funding for the university's operations.

The spending plan shall be submitted to the university's board of trustees for review, approval, or if necessary, amendment by September 1, 2020, and each September 1 thereafter. The Board of Governors shall review, approve, and amend if necessary, each university's carry forward spending plan must include the estimated cost per planned expenditure and a timeline for completion of the expenditure." Three additional tabs are provided with this file to allow reporting of university detailed expenditure plans for each planned expenditure or project, a completion timeline, and amount budgeted for expenditure during the reporting fiscal year.
