#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

In June 2012, the Provost issued new policies and procedures for the development of new academic degree programs. This process included, for the first time, a procedure for the preliminary review of proposed programs by the Provost, prior to the development of full proposal for approval by the FAU Board of Trustees and, if applicable, by the Florida Board of Governors. The New Degree Program Feasibility Study Form was developed for this purpose.

At the same time, the Council of Academic Vice Presidents of the Florida State University System is interested in developing procedures for review of new programs as part of an academic coordination process. A workgroup composed of Provosts and Provost's representatives is in the process of developing a format and procedure for review of any new degree program being proposed by any of the SUS institutions.
