This one day experience is designed to broaden student's leadership knowledge and engage them in conversations about effective leadership.

92% of students stated that they would recommend this leadership conference to others.

90% of students said the conference made them a stronger leader.



Certified Student Leader Program

- Year long program for students interested in refining their leadership knowledge, application, and skills through a variety of leadership opportunities.
- Upon completion, this program enables students to receive a stamp on their official transcript.

Enrollment: Since the program began, 532 students have enrolled.
This semester, 181 students are enrolled.

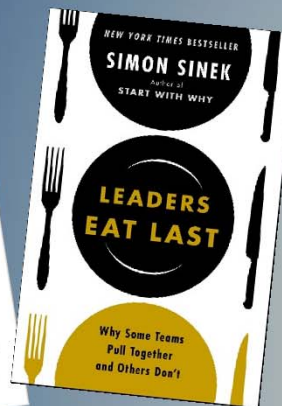
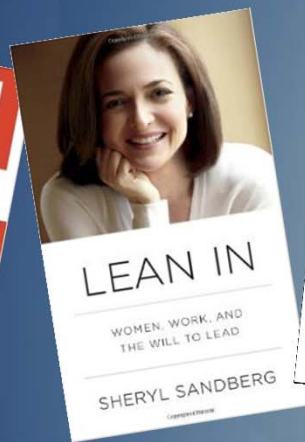
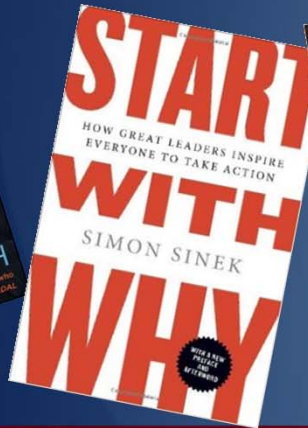
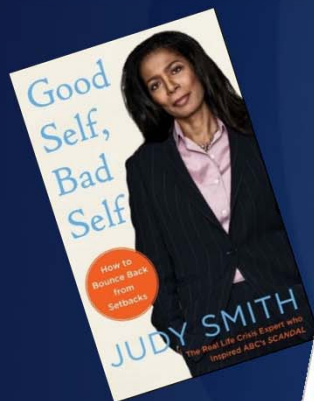
Emerging Young Leaders Program

A mentorship program for freshman and sophomore standing students. 35 students in Boca Raton and 10 in Jupiter are a part of the program, seeking to enhance their scholarship, personal growth, and social engagement. All students attend iLead, join a Reading Circle, pair with an Elite Owl Mentor, and get more involved and engaged at FAU!



Leadership Reading Circles

- Since its existence, **393** students have participated and **24** faculty have led Circles.
- 30 students are currently enrolled in four reading circles across the Boca, Jupiter, and Davie Campuses. Three more circles starting this month with approximately 30 more students expected.



Co-Curricular Transcripts (CCT)

- The co-curricular transcript demonstrates a student's commitment to involvement activities that complements their academic transcript.
- The experiences students include on the co-curricular transcript showcase their experience and accomplishments outside of the classroom giving them a competitive edge for employment and graduate school applications.
