SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF THE REVISED FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN (2015-16 / 2019-20)

PROPOSED COMMITTEE ACTION

Recommend approval of the Revised 2015-16 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP-2).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On June 17, 2014, the Board of Trustees approved the 2015-16 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) identifying the academic and academic support capital projects projected over the next five-year period. The following items are being requested as revisions/updates to the CIP:

- 1. A.D. Henderson University School increased project scope and funding request; and,
- 2. The Schmidt Family Complex for Academic and Athletic Excellence new project request

A.D. Henderson University School

The initial request for the A.D. Henderson project, as previously approved by the BOT, comprised of replacing the 1967 building consisting of 47,000 GSF at a total cost of \$25 million dollars. This need was based on a 2013 facilities assessment which provided a detailed evaluation of building systems, space needs and design elements. The assessment report highlighted concerns related to the age of the mechanical systems, the presence of asbestos laden materials, ADA accessibility issues, aging roof membrane, and insufficient space for adequate programmatic and instructional needs. Submission of this report to the Florida Department of Education resulted in FDOE's support of razing and replacing the 1967 building in lieu of rehabilitating the existing structure.

Further review and analysis of the site conditions through a master planning study necessitated the expansion of the project to include: (i) replacement of the middle school portable classrooms, (ii) reconfiguration of the site to address issues associated with traffic flow, safety concerns with drop-off/pick-up zones, and parking needs, and (iii) the inclusion of a much needed indoor gymnasium and an auditorium, each programmed to accommodate 600 seats.

The revised program consists of 131,500 GSF at a total project cost of \$41.5 million. The project will provide state-of-the-art classrooms and labs to complement and enhance the curriculum, research, and teacher training in meeting the school's primary mission of providing a first class education to primary and secondary students. The project will also provide added value to FAU High students, who will also benefit from many of the new and enhanced improvements. The new facility will also include space for STEM programs, study space, teacher workrooms, and a new cafeteria and provide for upgraded infrastructure connectivity for mechanical and electrical systems.

Funding for this project will be requested over a three year horizon: \$3.9 million for planning in year one, \$34.7 million for construction in year two, and \$2.7 million in year three for furnishings and equipment.

The Schmidt Family Complex for Academic and Athletic Excellence

With a generous lead donation from the Schmidt Family, FAU is poised to build an intercollegiate academic and athletic facility that will further prepare and empower our student-athletes for academic, athletic, and lifetime achievement. The 185,000 GSF complex is contemplated to consist of the following program spaces: Academic Support Center; Strength, Conditioning & Wellness Center; a Sports Medicine Center; Football Operations and Administrations Center; Indoor Practice Facility; Athletics Department Administration Center; and Athletics History/Tradition Hall. Outdoor practice fields may also be provided as part of this complex planned to be constructed immediately west of the FAU Stadium and north of parking Garage III. Total project cost is included on the CIP-2 at \$50 million dollars, which will be raised from private funds. Planning and design are expected to be completed in the first half of 2015, at which point proposed amendments to the Campus Master Plan will be presented to the Board for approval.

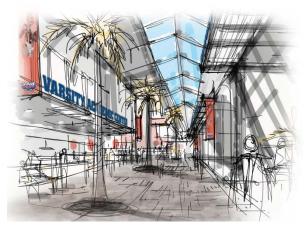

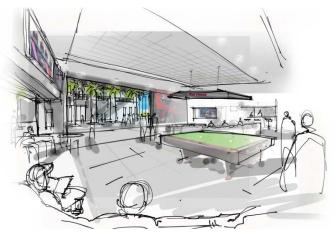
