SUBJECT: Approve Naming of University Elements

PROPOSED BOARD ACTION

Approve naming of the science lab (the "Element") within the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex (the "ADHUS/FAU High School Complex"). The proposed name of the science lab will be the "Science Lab Graciously Donated by an Anonymous Henderson Family" until December 31, 2027 and thereafter the name of the Science Lab will be updated to the "Frankel Zagha Science Lab".

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Donation:

Dr. Ralph Zagha and Dr. Stacey Frankel are donating Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for a recognition opportunity to name the science lab at the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex.

Gift Purpose:

The gift will be used to assist with the planning, financing, constructing, and equipping the ADHUS/FAU High School Complex, under the direction and within the discretion of the Assistant Dean of PK-12 Educational Programs.

Donors' Background:

Ralph M. Zagha is a doctor specializing in urology. In 2006, he founded his own practice in Lauderdale Lakes, Florida. He serves as chief of staff for Florida Medical Center campus of North Shore where he served as chief of surgery from 2010 to 2013. Dr. Ralph Zagha earned his medical degree from Tufts University in 2000, and he earned a B.S. in Chemistry and Biochemistry from University of California, San Diego in 1996. Dr. Zagha completed his residency at Boston Children's Hospital's Lahey Clinic and Massachusetts General Hospital. He holds a medical license in Florida and Massachusetts.

Stacy J. Frankel is a doctor, and she is certified in dermatology. In 2006, she founded her own practice in Lauderdale Lakes, Florida. Dr. Stacy Frankel earned her medical degree from University of Miami in 2001, and she earned a B.S. in Biology from University of Miami in 1997. Dr. Frankel completed

her residency at University of Miami and Massachusetts General Hospital. She also earned a fellowship from Boston Dermatology and Laser Center. She holds a medical license in Florida and Massachusetts.

The couple married in 2005, and they reside in Coral Springs, Florida.
