SAND VOLLEYBALL RULES Men's, Women's and Co-Rec

National Federation and Intramural Sports Volleyball Rules apply with the following modifications:

1. Teams should report to the Intramural Staff a minimum of 15 minutes prior to their scheduled playing time. Game time is forfeit time. A current FAU photo I.D. card must be presented before each participation by each player.
2. Teams will play 2 out of 3 games to 25 points, all points will be rally points. Teams must win a game by at least 2 points. Teams are to switch sides of the court after every 10 points scored during the third game. A 15 minute time limit will be in effect for each game.
3. Officials will be provided by the Campus Recreation.
5. Teams are responsible for knowing their playing schedule. In case of inclement weather, please call 297-1162 or check at www.fau.edu/campusrec for information regarding games and alternate playing sites.
6. Teams may have no more than 9 players on their roster. A player must play in at least one game before the final to be eligible for the final game.
7. The 10 foot line spiking rule will not be in effect for the Men's, Women's, and Co-Rec sand game.
8. Teams will play a single elimination tournament.
9. Overhand or underhand serves will be permitted.
10. Substitution: Free substitution is permitted. The only restrictions are: 1) no more than 6 players/team may be on the court during a live ball; 2) no more than 3 players of one sex may be on the court during a live ball(co-rec); 3) substitutions must be acknowledged by the official(s) and made during a dead ball.
11. **Co-Rec** - Teams participate with 3 men and 3 women. The minimum number of players is 4. In Co-Rec, 2 males and 2 females are needed to start a match.
12. **Co-Rec**- If more than one player contacts the ball a woman must touch the ball. The order of hits is not relevant.
13. If an intramural participant is ejected from any intramural contest they are immediately ineligible for further competition in any intramural activity, until they are cleared by the Coordinator for Sports and Competition or his/her designate. In addition, any unsportsmanlike conduct by a player or fan may cause their team to be disqualified from the tournament.
14. Participants should be aware that there is a risk of injury in participation of intramural sports due to the inherent nature of the activity. Individuals are encouraged to have a physical examination and to obtain adequate health and accident insurance prior to participation. Individuals participate in intramural activities at their own risk!
