HOW TO ENABLE ZOOM IN YOUR COURSE



ENABLE ZOOM IN YOUR COURSE

1. After opening a course, click on the **Settings** link in the Course Navigation Menu.



- 2. Click on the Navigation tab at the top of the Settings page.
- 3. Locate the **Zoom** menu item in the bottom half of the page.
- 4. Enable the **Zoom** menu item by performing **one** of the following steps:
 - A. Click and drag the item from the Disabled Items list (bottom) into the Enabled Items list (top).
 - B. Click the ellipsis (three-dots) to the right of the item and click + Enable.
- 5. Click the blue **Save** button at the bottom of the page.
- 6. Upon returning to your course's home page, you will see the **Zoom** link in the Course Navigation Menu.
