The purpose of these grants is to provide financial assistance to faculty and staff involved in Community Engaged Research (CeR) projects.

Proposals are sought from faculty and/or staff engaged with community partners in developing projects that have the potential to significantly impact or solve societal issues. The projects should be guided by the principles of Engaged Research, ensuring "mutually beneficial exchange of knowledge and resources in a context of partnership and reciprocity."

Eligibility:

Faculty and staff with full time appointments working collaboratively with community partners may apply.

Review Criteria:

Proposals will be reviewed by the C-CEL Committee and submitted to the Executive Director for final approval.

Last Friday of October Submission Deadline for Application Packet is 5 pm

November Review of Applications

4 Weeks after Deadline Fund Disbursement (up to \$1,000) through departmental accounts

Awardees will be required to file a report detailing the results of the grant. Not completing this requirement will disqualify the individual for consideration for future funding.
