

## **Alcohol and Drug Counseling Services**

At the Counseling Center, we understand that college students are making important decisions about their use of alcohol, and students see an Alcohol and Drug Counselor for a variety of reasons:

- o Desire for assistance in moderating their use of alcohol
- o Concern about friends' or family members' use of alcohol or other drugs
- o Referral from the Student Health Center or other medical or mental health providers
- o Assistance in finding recovery resources and maintaining abstinence in the campus atmosphere
- o Referral from Student Conduct or other Florida Atlantic University staff when there is concern about a student's alcohol or drug use or when there has been a violation of the policy.
- o Family request
- o Court mandates for assessment, counseling, or other services
- o Voluntary/ Mandated Counseling
- o Individual/ Couples/ Family/ Crisis Counseling
- o Mandated Counseling
- o Comprehensive assessment
- o Consultation
- o Recommendation and referral to other agencies as indicated
- o Prevention and university collaboration
- o Education about specific issues emerging from the assessment
- o Structure and support for those trying to reduce their alcohol consumption
- o Addressing impact of alcohol and drug use on other physical or mental health diagnoses
- o Short-term individual or group therapy
