Complete the A.A. degree at the community/state college. Several General Education requirements may also meet course requirements for the major. A transfer student without an A.A. degree and with less than 60 acceptable credits must meet entering freshman test score and GPA requirements.

Students are encouraged to complete the lower-division courses during the program of study at the community/state college. They must be completed after admission to FAU if not done so in advance with a grade of "C" or greater.

**COLLEGE OF EDUCATION POLICIES**

Admission to the College of Education is contingent upon the student meeting the following requirements:

- a 2.5 GPA
- passing all sections of the General Knowledge Test
- a successful interview with the College

Students must meet with advisors prior to registration.

Students must refer to the university catalog for university- and degree-wide graduation requirements.
