## APPLICATION DEADLINES AND PROCESS

**Early Action (non-binding)** – Applications received by December 15<sup>th</sup> will have a decision by February 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Regular** – Applications received after December 15<sup>th</sup> will be considered until the class is filled.

**A complete application** includes: (a) FAU application, (b) \$30.00 application fee, (c) supplemental application form, (d) official transcripts, (e) official SAT or ACT score report, (f) two letters of evaluation, (g) graded writing sample, and (h) résumé.

*Because space is limited in the entering class and in the residence halls, students are encouraged to apply for admission as early as possible.*
