



WILKES MEDICAL SCHOLARS PROGRAM EARLY ADMISSION TO MEDICAL SCHOOL

The Wilkes Honors College and the Charles E. Schmidt College of Medicine at Florida Atlantic University are excited to announce the new Wilkes Medical Scholars Program. This is an early admission program into Medical School for qualified high school seniors and is available for freshman students planning to begin college in the Fall of 2012.

Students will receive their Bachelors Degree and the M.D. degree in seven or eight years. Admission is open to highly qualified high school seniors who strongly desire to pursue medicine as a career.

Those accepted into the Wilkes Medical Scholars Program will enter the Wilkes Honors College assured of a spot in the Medical School, provided they successfully complete the program requirements and score at least a 29 on the MCAT.

Minimum requirements to enter the program:

- SAT score of 1350 (Critical Reading and Math combined) or ACT equivalent of at least 31
- 3.75 unweighted high school GPA
- US citizen or permanent resident status at time of application; Florida resident
- Must be admitted to the Wilkes Honors College
